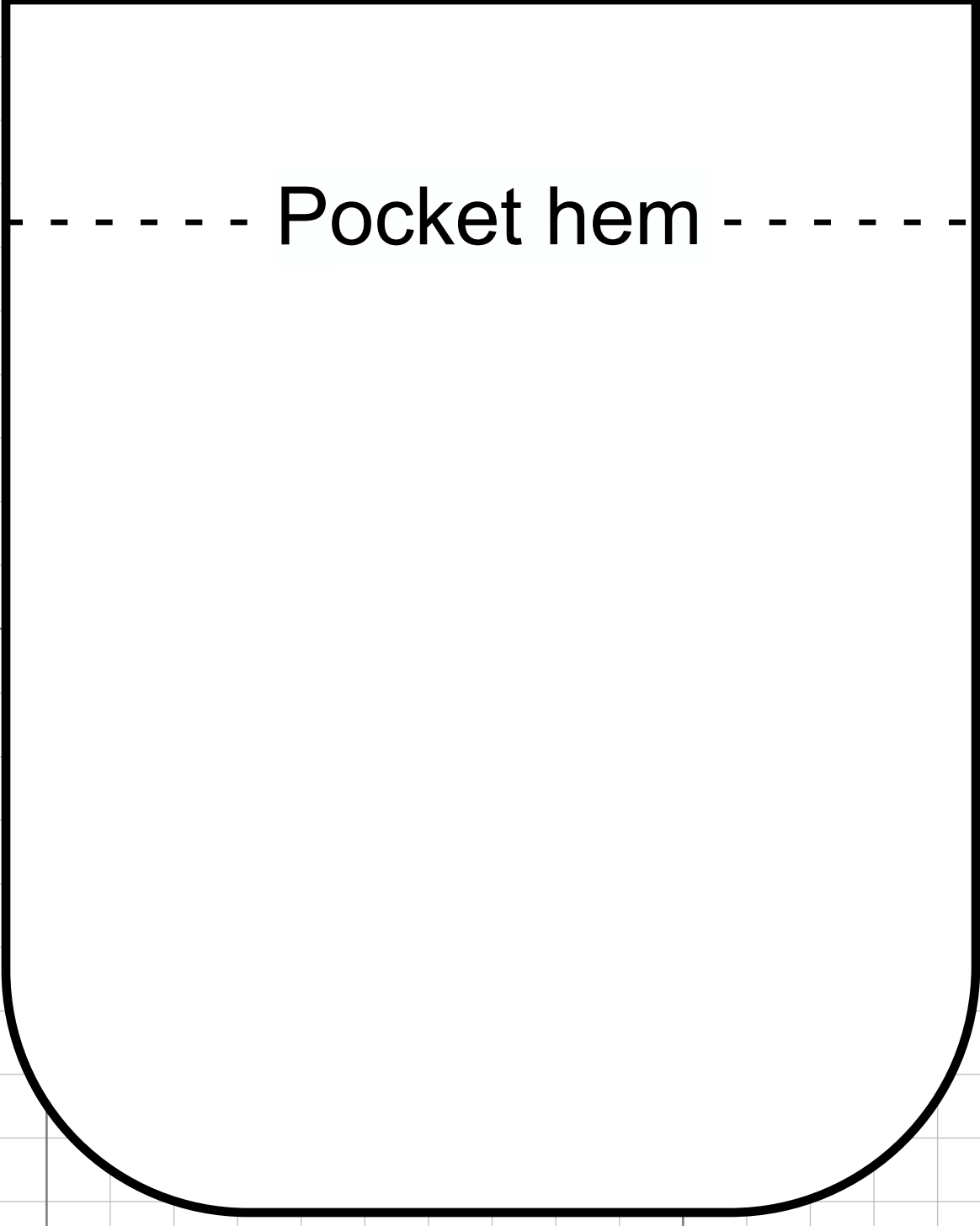


Do not sew lining here

Do not sew lining here

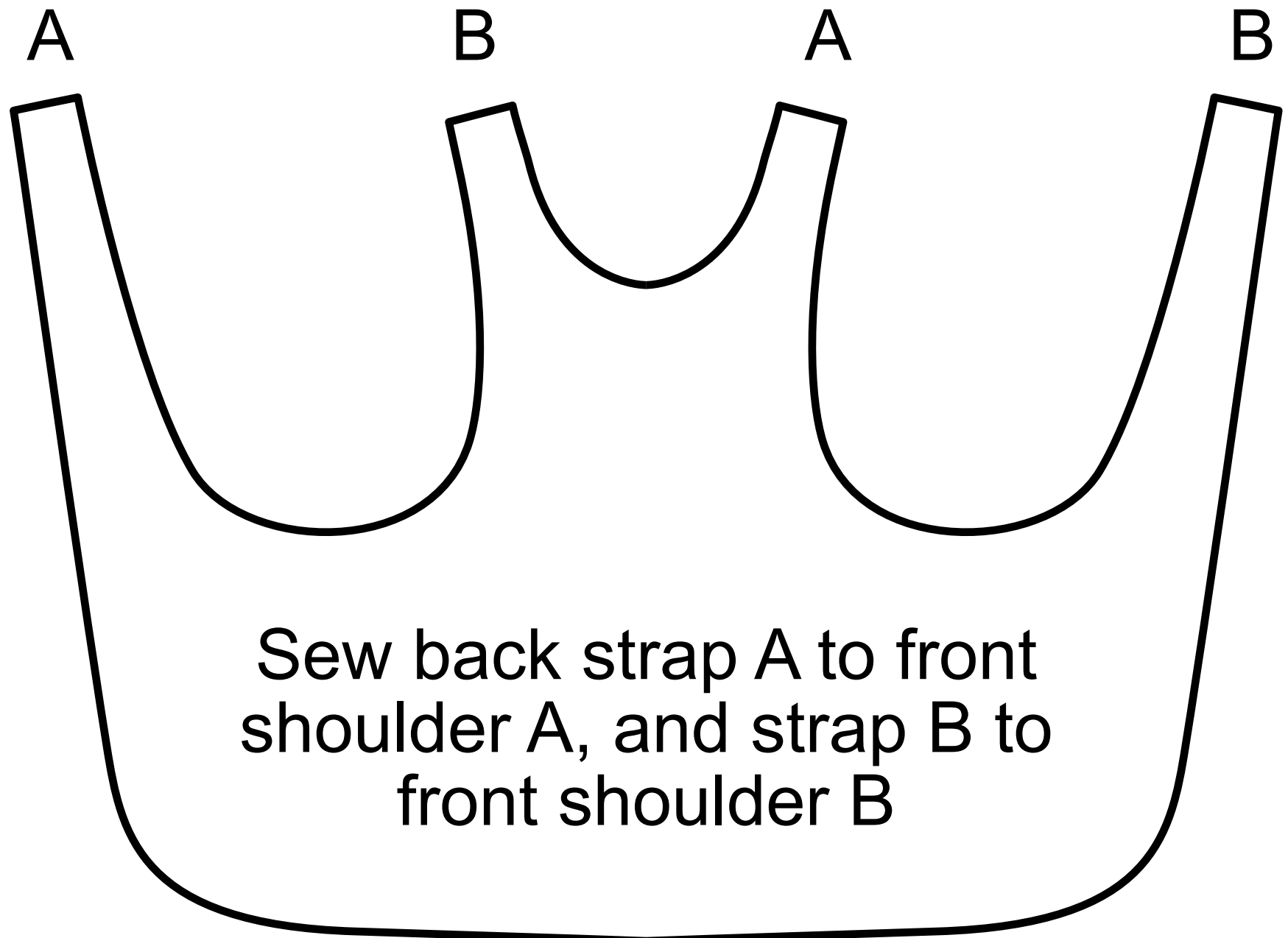


Pocket hem

On one side, leave an opening in this area for turning right side out

Cut on fold

- **Seam allowances are not included**
- One yard of 54" wide fabric is needed of fabric and lining
- Cut one piece each of main pattern
- Cut two pockets, and two pocket linings if desired
- Pin right sides together, and sew along neck, back, and side, leaving an opening on one side for turning. Do not sew strap openings
- Turn right side out, and press all seams
- Hand sew or carefully topstitch side opening closed
- Turn seam allowance of front shoulder openings to the inside, slide back straps inside front shoulder openings, then topstitch
- Topstitch all edges
- Put on the smock and place the pockets where desired. Topstitch pockets in place.
- If scaling pattern by hand, Imperial grid lines are 1" apart; metric are 1cm. apart



Sew back strap A to front shoulder A, and strap B to front shoulder B
